OPTIONAL COMPOST COLLECTION

- Acceptable Yard Waste: grass clippings, leaves, shrubs, and brush trimmings (under 6 inches in diameter, bundled and tied, no longer than 4 feet in length).
- Unacceptable Yard Waste: sod, pet waste, dead animals, dirt, rocks, root balls, oversized branches, plastics.
- Weekly collection starts April 1st every year and ends December 10th every year.
- We will collect Christmas Trees beginning Christmas week and running through January 31st.
- All compost material must be placed in paper bags or clearly marked containers with a maximum capacity of 45 gallons and weighing less than 60 pounds.

OPTIONAL RECYCLING COLLECTION ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING MATERIALS:

- Clean plastic bottles & Containers #1-7
- Clean food & beverage cans or cartons

- Clean flattened cardboard & paperboard
- Clear and colored glass bottles

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

- Your service day will remain the same as the current schedule.
- We start collection at 7am until we are finished. The time you are serviced is subject to change week to week and we recommend placing your materials to the curb the night before your collection day.
- You can use your current container as long as it does not exceed 96-gallons in size. If there are excess materials that do not fit inside the container, place them next to the container at least 3 feet away and bagged. The container and bagged materials cannot exceed 60 pounds in weight.
- Bulk item service is allowed. Items included in the bulk waste collection are furniture (i.e. couches, chairs, tables, beds, mattresses, box springs), refrigerators with freon removed and tagged, up to 5 rolls of carpet and padding (cut into 3' or 4' widths, rolled folded, and tied-manageable for one person to handle), bathtubs, sinks, toilets, disassembled swing sets, garage doors that are cut into sections and tied into bundles, glass windows, and wooden fencing that are cut into 3-foot lengths and bundled no more than 60 pounds. If you are not sure about an item, please call at **586-228-1200** or **855-WASTE-65.**
- Excluded items are large amounts of building refuse, bricks, concrete blocks, and large quantities of furnishings and materials resulting from fire, basement flooding, or similar occurances.



SIGN UP FOR SERVICE

As your new provider, we need all residents to register for service. You can sign up online on or after Sept. 7 OR our team will be at the Township Hall September 15 and 17 from 9am-12pm, and September 20 from 12pm-5pm to help facilitate signing up for service. Please bring a method of payment and a form of I.D.. Deadline to sign up for service is September 20th to avoid service disruption. 
